

Health & Wellness Committee Meeting Minutes June 24, 2024, 7:00pm - 8:00pm Zoom Meeting

- I. Meeting called to order by Committee Chair Dhir at 7:02pm.
- II. Roll call completed by Committee Chair Dhir.
- III. Committee Chair Dhir read Housekeeping and Meeting Guidelines.
- IV. Approval of Agenda: Commissioner Fox made a motion to approve the agenda and was seconded by Commissioner Martin. Motion carried with all in favor.
- V. Approval of Minutes from 4.15.2023. Chair Dhir called for a vote to approve the minutes and the minutes were approved with an abstention from Commissioner Jones.
- VI. Discussion of HIV Funding:
 - A. Chair Dhir presented a summary of the HIV Funding Crisis including recent actions, including:
 - 1. The Commission approved a statement at the May meeting.
 - 2. Resolution from the Baltimore City Council introduced by Councilperson Zeke Cohen.
 - 3. Baltimore Collaborative meeting with Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD) discussed services that will be cut.
 - B. The Committee discussed the following items:
 - 1. Need to meet with stakeholders.

- 2. Upper Eastern Shore is ending several HIV services including mobile clinics which is also affecting reproductive health as well. Ryan White funding was piggy backing on reproductive health.
- 3. Explore alternative funding streams, including funding that may be available from hospital systems to certain zip codes.
- 4. Director Browning shared the 5 year plan prepared by the Maryland Department of Health HIV Planning Committee (HPC).
- C. Next Steps: Get involved in existing HIV groups and meet with the Maryland Department of Health HPC.
- VII. Discussion: Trans Health Equity Act implementation/access challenges:
 - A. Chair Blinder provided a summary of the implementation progress and challenges, including:
 - 1. Insurance companies changing criterias.
 - 2. Lack of electrolysis and hair removal providers in the Medicaid network.
 - 3. Difficulties navigating the Maryland healthcare system.
 - 4. No entity to legally hold MCOs accountable.
 - 5. Network adequacy not enforced.
 - B. Discussions included:
 - 1. Impact litigation.
 - 2. Ethics of equitable distribution of resources.
- VIII. Discussion on 2025 Policy Priorities will occur at the next meeting due to time constraints.
- IX. Adjournment: Commissioner Dhir adjourned the 8:00pm.
