Maryland Day to Serve 2016 Tips to Get Started

Want to get involved in Day to Serve? Not sure where to begin? Here's how:

- Develop your event idea. It can be anything from donating food to low-income families to cleaning up a state park. Be creative!
 (If you're an individual looking to volunteer, visit <u>http://daytoserve.org/map</u> to find events in your area).
- 2. **Register your event.** Once you've come up with an idea, register your event at <u>http://daytoserve.org/addyourevent</u>.
 - Login /create a new user name.
 - Complete the form describing your event and the organizations involved.
 - Follow the links in the confirmation email you receive to finalize your account. Check your spam folder if you do not see the confirmation within a few minutes.
 - Go to <u>http://daytoserve.org/map</u> and look for your event on the Day to Serve event map.
- 3. **Reach out** to volunteers in your community. Gather as many people as you need to make your event a success!
- 4. Edit your event on <u>http://daytoserve.org/</u> using your account login information if any details about your event change before it begins.
- 5. **Remind** your volunteers before the event so they don't forget. Make sure everyone knows the time, place, and purpose of your Day to Serve 2016 event.
- 6. **Upload** pictures and the results of your event on <u>http://daytoserve.org/</u> using your account. Collect information on:
 - Number of volunteers
 - Number of youth volunteers (under 18)
 - Hours of volunteer service (including planning)
 - Amount of food collected (number of cans, boxes, or lbs.)
 - Amount of garbage/debris collected (number of trash bags or lbs)
 - Number of trees planted
 - Any other measure of significance
