WHEREAS, The State of Maryland is committed to upholding the values of diversity, inclusion, and equality, ensuring that every individual, regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity, can live, work, and thrive without fear of discrimination or prejudice; and

WHEREAS, The observance of Lesbian Visibility Week emphasizes the importance of visibility, empowerment, and solidarity in continuing to fight for the rights and dignity of all people, especially those who identify as lesbian; and
